




unspoilt beaches and lagoons of the Mamanuca island group and see the world's best kept secret unfold before your eyes.











Day 5 - Natadola Beach Tour With Veisabasaba Village Visit trip to Fiji

boat.



🔒 small town with a big heart, Sigatoka and the Coral Coast will steal your heart with its friendly locals. amazing food and culture and spectacular surroundings. From towering. green mountains and rolling hills and valleys to the translucent and pure waters of the sea, everywhere the eye sees beauty. Look around for intriguing souvenirs at a local handicraft market, witness traditional practises at a frozen-in-time village, and watch artists make elusive pottery and palm furniture.





Take a ride over rugged landscapes in an all-terrain vehicle to the fortress-like grotto that was once home to one of Fiji's native tribes. Step into the hidden world at the Naihehe Caves, and visit the home of a village priest to participate in a traditional kava ceremony.

The name Naihehe means "to get lost" in Fijian, and it's a fitting name for these secret caves deep within the Sigatoka Valley. During Fiji's tribal rivalry days, the Sautabu mountain people used the cave as a place of sanctuary, seeking shelter deep underground and climbing to a hidden opening to gather food when enemies surrounded its main entrance. Fiji's last tribal war took place here, after the Sautabu had camped out in the darkness for 79 days.





reathe in the fresh ocean air as you set sail for the open seas aboard a classic schooner. the Whale's Tale. This cruise packs 5 stunning islands of the Mamanuca island group and snorkel-ready lagoons into one full day under the sun.

Chat with the skipper's on board, and decide to take the wheel, or sit back over breakfast with a glass of champagne and relax to passing sights of surrounding palm-fringed islands. Beachcombers can spend the day searching for shells, making sand castles, or turning to the sun for a much needed dose of Vitamin D.






Day 13 - Sunset Dinner Cruise trip to Fiji
